## **Components and Installation Instructions**

**General Information:** Your vehicle must have a 12 volt power source to hook up this horn unit.

**(NOTE: Our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location)**

You can wrap your horn in a plastic bag after it is mounted under the hood or other location to help keep it dry and out of direct water contact. The sound will go through the thin plastic bag without any noticeable decrease in sound volume.

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## **Boom Blasters Components**

1. Big Bubba 4 BUTTON WIRELESS Horn Unit
2. (4 Button) Remote Control
3. USB Cable (use when uploading your sound files)
4. Instructions

**Tools - Parts Needed** (not provided):

1. Pliers
2. Wrench or suitable tool to connect power wires to battery or fuse panel.
3. Bolts & nuts to mount it down.
4. A few tie downs straps to safely secure the wiring.
5. Windows Computer w/USB port (To upload your preferred sound file)
6. You may require additional wiring depending on where you mount your horn unit.

Installation should take around 10-15 minutes.

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules.

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## **Big Bubba "Wireless" 4 Sounds Horn Unit**

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Our BIG BUBBA WIRELESS horn unit is unique because you can simply upload your own 4 sound files via your computer USB port.

Simply hook up the horn unit via the supplied USB cable to your Windows computer, upload the 4 sound files that you want to play, and then hook it up to your vehicle and your ready to go.

**We do NOT supply sound files for you to download to your car horn, this unit was sold to you with that understanding...therefore we do not offer technical support for searching, finding and editing sound files for you to install on your horn...**

If you need HELP...then make sure that you visit our tutorials section...we have videos there to help you understand how to upload and edit your sound files.

### **Connecting The USB Horn To Your Windows Computer**

1. Big Bubba WIRELESS can only connect and read files on "WINDOWS" computer systems. (NOT MACS)
2. Hook up your horn unit via the supplied USB cable to your Windows computer...our horn unit works just like a removable thumb drive. (if you know how to use a portable thumb drive, then this will be super easy for you to do)
3. After a few seconds you will see a popup box asking you to open the folder or you can simply navigate to "My Computer" and manually open up the drive to access the internal memory of the horn unit.
4. You will then see 4 sound sample sound files in that folder, you will need to delete those 4 sound files and upload your own 4 sound files.
5. Our Big Bubba WIRELESS USB horn units ONLY accept MP3 sound file and cannot be any larger than 3 megabytes in size (most sound files are very small anyways, so you should have no worries about file size)
6. After downloading your new sound files to your Big Bubba WIRELESS USB horn unit all you need to do now is go test it and then hook it up to your vehicle.

**Remember our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location and mount it away from any moving parts.**

You can wrap your horn in a plastic bag after it is mounted under the hood or other location to help keep it dry and out of direct water contact. The sound will go through the thin plastic bag without any noticeable decrease in sound volume.

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**Big Bubba "Wireless" 4 Sounds Horn Unit**

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**Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution!**

1. Do not install this unit while the vehicle is running!
2. When the unit is installed, ensure the wiring harness power lead wires are attached to the battery correctly. Red to Red (Positive), Black to Black (Negative).
3. Secure the unit properly and ensure the unit and all wiring are clear of any moving parts (i.e. fan belts, etc.) or items that can cause damage to the unit.
4. **NOTE:** Our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location and wrap a plastic bag around it to help keep it dry.

**Installation Instructions**

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**NOTE: If you do not feel comfortable installing the Boom Blasters Horn unit, please seek qualified professional assistance.**

**Step 1: Battery Connection**

- a. Install the Big Bubba Wireless Unit in the engine compartment close to the battery and away from any moving parts or areas that may cause damage to the unit or the vehicle. **(The wiring harness red and black wire needs to be able to reach and connect to the battery.)**
- b. Connect the black wire from the wiring harness to the negative (-) side of the battery.
- c. Connect the red wire from the wiring harness to the positive (+) side of the battery.

**Note:**

- 1) **Ensure all connections are tightened properly! (DO NOT test unit holding the wires with your fingers...this is NOT a good connection and your horn unit will probably not function)**
- 2) **Route wires neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage.**

**Step 2: Speaker Installation**

Install the speaker in a convenient location, but ensure the speaker wires will reach the unit.

**Note: Route the speaker wire neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage.** The sound volume of the unit may vary depending on the placement of the speaker.

**Connecting Your Wireless Horn Unit**

1. Connect power according to wire color, red goes the positive, black goes to negative.
2. Press one of the buttons on the remote control unit ONE time to turn on your horn to play the sound.
3. When your horn is activated it will continue to play all the way through to the end of the sound file that is installed on your horn unit. (NOTE: there is NO pause function)

That's it! now go and hook up your horn.
