Components and Installation Instructions

General Information: This horn is controlled by using a momentary horn button or with a toggle switch. (momentary button is included)

(NOTE: Our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location) You can wrap your horn in a plastic bag after it is mounted under the hood or other location to help keep it dry and out of direct water contact. The sound will go through the thin plastic bag without any noticeable decrease in sound volume.

Your vehicle must have a 12 volt power source to hook up this horn unit.

Check out our videos explaining exactly how this horn unit functions and how to hook it up correctly...if you can't get your horn to work, then watching our videos will probably help you.

TIP: Read through entire instructions carefully before beginning the installation process.

Tools - Parts Needed (not provided):

- 1. Pliers
- 2. Wrench or suitable tool to connect power wires to battery
- 3. Additional wires may also be required for the power, ground and trigger wires.
- 4. Bolts & nuts to mount it down.
- 5. A few tie downs straps to safely secure the wiring.
- 6. You may require additional wiring depending on where you mount your unit and your button location.

Installation should take around 45 to 60 minutes.

Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution!

- 1. Do not install this Unit while the vehicle is running!
- 2. When the Unit is installed, ensure the wiring harness power lead wires are attached to the battery correctly. Red to Red (Positive), Black to Black (Negative).
- 3. Secure the Unit properly and ensure the Unit and all wiring are clear of any moving parts (i.e. fan belts, etc.) or items that can cause damage to the Unit.

Boom Blasters Installation Instructions

NOTE: If you do not feel comfortable installing the Boom Blasters Horn Unit, seek qualified professional assistance.

Step 1: Battery Connection

- a. Install the Boom Blasters Unit in the engine compartment close to the battery and away from any moving parts or areas that may cause damage to the Unit or the vehicle. (**The wiring harness red and black wire needs to be able to reach and connect to the battery.**)
- b. Connect the black wire from the wiring harness to the negative (-) side of the battery.
- c. Connect the red wire from the wiring harness to the positive (+) side of the battery.

Note:

- 1) Ensure all connections are tightened properly! (DO NOT test unit holding the wires with your fingers...this is NOT a good connection and your horn unit will probably not function)
- 2) Route wires neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage.

Step 2: Speaker Installation

Install the speaker in a convenient location, but ensure the speaker wires will reach the Unit.

Note: Route the speaker wire neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage. The sound volume of the Unit may vary depending on the placement of the speaker.

Remember our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location.

Testing Boom Blasters Unit

- 1. "TOUCH" the yellow wire once (1 time) to the positive (+) post on the battery to the test unit.
- 2. The Unit will then activate and play.
- 3. When your horn unit is activated it will continue to play all the way through to the end of the sound file. (NOTE: there is NO pause function)

That's it! now go and hook up your horn.
