Components and Installation Instructions

General Information: Your vehicle must have a 12 volt power source to hook up this horn unit.

(NOTE: Our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location)

You can wrap your horn in a plastic bag after it is mounted under the hood or other location to help keep it dry and out of direct water contact. The sound will go through the thin plastic bag without any noticeable decrease in sound volume.

Check out our videos explaining exactly how this horn unit functions and how to hook it up correctly...if you can't get your horn to work, then watching our videos will probably help you.

TIP: Read through entire instructions carefully before beginning the installation process.

Boom Blasters Components

- 1. Boom Blasters Wireless Horn Unit
- 2. (1) Remote Control
- 3. Instructions Manual

Tools - Parts Needed (not provided):

- 1. Pliers
- 2. Wrench or suitable tool to connect power wires to battery
- 3. Bolts & nuts to mount it down.
- 4. A few tie downs straps to safely secure the wiring.
- 5. You may require additional wiring depending on where you mount your horn unit.

Installation should take around 10-15 minutes.

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules.

Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution! Caution!

- 1. Do not install this unit while the vehicle is running!
- 2. When the unit is installed, ensure the wiring harness power lead wires are attached to the battery correctly. Red to Red (Positive), Black to Black (Negative).
- 3. Secure the unit properly and ensure the unit and all wiring are clear of any moving parts (i.e. fan belts, etc.) or items that can cause damage to the unit.
- 4. **NOTE:** Our horns are NOT waterproof, so be sure to mount it in a dry location and wrap a plastic bag around it to help keep it dry.

Installation Instructions

NOTE: If you do not feel comfortable installing the Boom Blasters Horn unit, please seek qualified professional assistance.

Step 1: Battery Connection

- a. Install the Boom Blasters Unit in the engine compartment close to the battery and away from any moving parts or areas that may cause damage to the unit or the vehicle. (**The wiring** harness red and black wire needs to be able to reach and connect to the battery.)
- b. Connect the black wire from the wiring harness to the negative (-) side of the battery.
- c. Connect the red wire from the wiring harness to the positive (+) side of the battery.

Note:

- 1) Ensure all connections are tightened properly! (DO NOT test unit holding the wires with your fingers...this is NOT a good connection and your horn unit will probably not function)
- 2) Route wires neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage.

Step 2: Speaker Installation

Install the speaker in a convenient location, but ensure the speaker wires will reach the unit.

Note: Route the speaker wire neatly away from any moving parts to prevent damage. The sound volume of the unit may vary depending on the placement of the speaker.

Connecting Your Wireless Horn Unit

- 1. Connect power according to wire color, red goes the positive, black goes to negative.
- 2. Press the button on the remote control unit ONE time to turn on your horn to play the sound.
- 3. When your horn is activated it will continue to play all the way through to the end of the sound file

that is installed on your horn unit. (NOTE: there is NO pause function)

That's it! now go and hook up your horn.
